Things You Should Know:

- All current services such as delivery, meter readings, billing, payments, emergency services etc. are serviced through PSE&G just as they are today. You will get one (1) bill from PSE&G.
- PSE&G does not generate the energy provided through their utility. They buy the energy through a statewide auction called the BGS auction which stands for Basic Generation Service. This is the default service all

residents are on if you do not select a third party supplier. Information can be found at http://www.bgs-auction.com/.

- This program offers a reduced rate on the supply portion of your electric bill. You will still be billed for delivery charges from PSE&G, just as you are today.
- The rate offered is flat for the term of the contract and is NOT a variable rate.
- This program offers protections for residents that are generally not available to individuals looking to obtain a
 third party contracted rate. These protections are a main reason the Township is providing this program as a
 benefit to residents.
- Budget billing will be offered. Please read the accompanying page to obtain more information on budget billing.
- To obtain the program rate, there is nothing you need to do. All eligible residents will be automatically
 enrolled unless you choose to opt out of the program.
- The ability to Opt Out is a mandate of the state statute that governs this process. An Opt In program is not available for residential service.
- There are no fees to be a part of the program. You may opt out at any time with no fee or penalty even after the initial opt out time period.
- If you opted out and wish to rejoin, you may do so at any time, again with no fee.
- You may continue to call PSE&G for billing questions or Constellation NewEnergy, Inc.. All numbers will be found on your electricity bill.
- The offered rate will be shown on your bill and you may compare this against PSE&G's rate each month. Both rates will be plainly printed on your bill so the rate reduction is apparent.
- At the end of this term a new rate will be offered and you will be provided that information at that time.
 Alternatively if we cannot obtain another reduced rate for a new term, you will automatically be switched back to PSF&G.
- If you already have a third party provider, you will not be automatically included, but you may join if you choose. This mailer is sent only to those residents who have not chosen a third party supplier. If you have a third party supplier, you may choose to join the program at any time by calling Concord Energy Services through our partners, Commercial Utility Consultants, at 877-292-3904. Please checkyour terms and conditions to ensure that there are no early termination fees for canceling your current third party service.
- If you have solar panels on your property, you will not be automatically included, but you may join if you choose.
- Anyone receiving assistance for their utility bills will continue to receive it with this program.
- The Township does not receive any monetary benefit for providing this benefit to residents.
- The program's Energy Agents, Concord Energy Services, Inc., must follow all statutory guidelines implemented by the NJ Board of Public Utilities, which has enforcement authority over Community Energy Aggregation Programs in New Jersey. Key documents were provided to the NJ Board of Public Utilities and the Division of Rate Counsel staff for review and comment during the process.
- All information regarding this program is mailed through the US Postal Service. No one will call you or knock on your door regarding this program. Please be wary of anyone trying to get your information otherwise.

Budget Bill Program Information

For those residents who are on the budget bill program through PSE&G, please read the following information to make a decision on whether or not you wish to remain on the budget bill program with the energy Aggregation Program.

Your budget bill is comprised of both delivery and supply charges. Currently, Public Service Electric and Gas (PSE&G) provides both services and offers a budget amount based on your yearly average usage divided by 12 months.

If you wish to participate in the program, you will receive the reduced supply rate through Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. A budget plan will be provided for your delivery portion through PSE&G and the supply portion through Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. Both amounts should be close to your current budget plan amount as long as your current usage has not changed significantly.

- If you are currently on Budget Billing with PSE&G, you will automatically be enrolled in a budget bill plan with this program through Constellation NewEnergy, Inc.
- Your budget bill will be split into 2 parts. The portion for PSE&G will be automatically reduced and only
 include your delivery charges. The supply portion will be calculated and provided on your bill from
 Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. Both will be listed on your bill, however, you will continue to only pay PSE&G
 for both. You will not need to issue separate payments.
- The new budget amount will be based on your most current usage history for the last 12 months. After 6
 months, Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. will conduct an adjustment to your monthly budget amount to
 ensure your budget is in line with your actual usage.
- If you choose to leave the program you will be sent back to PSE&G who will provide your budget amount for you based on including the PSE&G supply rates.
- We encourage you to track your usage vs. your budgeted amount so you may stay current on your usage and charges.

Dear Pennsauken Township Resident:

Recently, the Township took advantage of a state law that allows us to establish a Municipal Energy Aggregation Program. This program permits the aggregation of all residential customers within the Township for the purpose of competitively purchasing electricity at rates lower than are currently available from your electric utility. The Township combined the electricity consumption of all residential customers in Pennsauken and received competitive bids from NJ BPU licensed suppliers to provide this electric supply service and provide savings to our residents.

How The Program Works: We obtained a rate that is lower than what PSE&G currently charges for the energy supply portion of your bill. This program offers a flat rate and is designed to offer some savings without the risk of rate increases; unlike other variable Third Party Supply (TPS) contracts. This means the rate will remain the same for term of the contract.

The auction results are **\$0.11999/kWh** offered by Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. (as compared to PSE&G's prevailing Price to Compare rate of \$0.12802/kWh). This rate will go into effect with your **July 2019** meter read and will continue through your November 2020 meter read date. For example, if your monthly electric usage is 700/kWh, your bill under this program will be \$83.99 for the supply portion versus \$89.61 that you would have paid with PSE&G. You will see the new program rate on your August 2019 electric bill.

PSE&G will continue to deliver your electricity and you will be billed at the regulated delivery rate. PSE&G will continue to provide all emergency and safety services. PSE&G will also continue to provide customer services such as meter reading, billing² and service restoration. You will also continue to only receive one bill and continue to pay PSE&G.

In accordance with the State's program requirements, as a Pennsauken Township resident you will be automatically enrolled in the program unless you opt-out by **May 30, 2019**. Once enrolled, **you may leave at any time and you will never have to pay any fees associated with joining or leaving the program.**³

How We Can Help You

As a residential electric customer who has not chosen a Third Party Supplier (TPS) for your electric supply, you will be automatically enrolled in this program unless you indicate your desire not to participate to receive the anticipated energy savings by completing and mailing the attached response card by May 30, 2019. You may also call 877-292-3904 to opt out or visit www.njaggregation.us/ptwp. Please note that wait times may be longer during high call time periods and please have your bill handy. Incentives	N/A
Right to Cancel/Rescind	This Agreement shall continue until the expiration of the specified term (unless either party provides prior notice of its intent to cancel) and until the EDC completes the termination in accordance with its rules. A customer may opt-out of this Agreement at any time during the 30 calendar days after the date on the Opt-Out notice, or at any time over the term of the contract without penalty, by calling 877-292-3904, visiting www.njaggregation.us/ptwp or returning the enclosed response card. You may cancel this agreement at any time without penalty.
Contract Start Date	Your account will begin receiving Electric Supply Service from CNE on the first available billing cycle date, as determined by your EDC, on or after 7/1/2019 .
Contract Term/Length	The Term of this Municipal Aggregation Program is 16 months and will end on or about 11/30/2020.
Cancellation / Termination Fees	There are no early termination fees associated with this Energy Aggregation Program.
Renewal Terms	At least 30 days prior to the expiration of the Term you will receive notice advising of your renewal options. This notice will inform you if a new rate and term will be available. If no savings can be offered, your account will automatically be returned to the utility as the default provider at the then prevailing rate per kilowatt hour for electricity supply. This will occur upon the first meter read after the expiration of the current Term. You may cancel this Agreement at any time without penalty.
